Guidelines & Eligibility:

The Vail Board of REALTORS® Foundation provides support to:

VBR members and members of the community needing financial assistance due to a catastrophic illness or accident, for use towards expenses related to medical issues or disaster relief.

Funding for Individuals in Need:

- Funds are given to help with expenses related to catastrophic illness or accidents not covered by insurance and disaster relief. [View full giving policy](#)
- Specific use of how the funds will be used must be identified in the application. The more information provided, the better for us to understand the situation.
- The Board of Directors will review all requests. The VBRF will review applications at meetings that are held every other month.
- Grant request is based on funds available.
