Guidelines and applications for funding for catastrophic disasters



The Vail Board of REALTORS® Foundation (VBRF) provides grants for organizations assisting in catastrophic disasters on a local, state, and national level. Grants are reviewed by following our giving policy and our mission statement: *“To assist the community and association members with need-based financial assistance, not-for-profit support, education, and disaster relief.”*

Please follow the guideline below when applying for a grant and note that applying does not guarantee that a grant will be awarded.

Guidelines & Eligibility:

Funding for Catastrophic Disasters:

- Applications from organizations applying for a grant must state their involvement and any responsibility related to the disaster, the role they’ve played in previous disaster assistance, if any, and specifically how the funds will be used. ([View full giving policy](#))
- The Board of Directors will review all requests. The VBRF will review applications at meetings that are held every other month.
- Grant amounts are based on funds available.
