BASIC CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

24

CREDITS IN A LICENSE CYCLE

Colorado licensed agents are required to complete 24 hours of Continuing Education (CE) within each of your 3-year licensing periods. This includes Annual CREC/ACU classes. Choose any CE classes for the remaining 12 hours, including Ethics.

ANNUAL CREC/ACU CLASS

Per the Division of Regulatory Agencies (DORA), all Realtors® are required to take this course every year. CREC can be taken online or in the classroom.

TAKEN BY ALL COLORADO LICENSED REAL ESTATE AGENTS ONCE PER YEAR.

NAR ETHICS CYCLE YEARS

The National Association of Realtors® requires Realtors® and Appraisers to take an Ethics course once every three years. Courses can be online or classroom, but must be at least *2.5 CE hours.

CURRENT CYCLE IS JANUARY 1, 2019 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2021.

PROCURING CAUSE CYCLE YEARS

Designated Realtors® (**Managing or Owner Brokers**) are required to complete Procuring Cause training once within a three-year cycle. Either a 2 or 3 hour course.

CURRENT CYCLE IS JANUARY 1, 2020 THROUGH DEC. 31, 2022

EDUCATION TRACKING

You are responsible for keeping track of all the education hours you have taken. Please keep organized, keep a virtual or paper file of certificates, and use VBR's Education Tracking Sheet to track this information.

*New Realtor® Members are required to take a 4-hour Ethics in-person at the Vail Board of Realtors® (within 90 days of membership activation). Applicants for secondary membership may disregard this requirement.
